

Last Will of Abigail Jordan, Thursday June 2nd, 1910. 22nd day of the May Term, 1910.

716. In the matter of the last Will and Testament

of Abigail Jordan, deceased.

An instrument of writing purporting to be the last will and testament of Abigail Jordan, deceased, late of this County, is now produced in open Court and application made by A.D. Babcock, for the probate thereof.

And comes now T.B. Cunningham who being duly sworn on oath says that he was one of the subscribing witnesses to said instrument of writing and testifies as to the due execution thereof by said decedent, her competency to so execute the same and that in such execution she was under no coercion or restraint; which testimony is reduced to writing subscribed by said witness and attested by the Clerk and the seal of this Court. And the Court being sufficiently advised now finds that said instrument has been duly proven and established as the last will and testament of said decedent and orders that the same as such be now admitted to probate and record in this Court; and the Clerk thereof is ordered to endorse thereon a certificate of such probate, which is accordingly now done. Said will, the testimony in proof thereof and the certificate of probate endorsed thereon, each read as follows, to-wit:

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT.

I, Abigail Jordan of Kentland Newton County Indiana do hereby make and publish this my last Will and Testament and do hereby revoke and annul all other instruments purporting to be my last will and testament.

I hereby dispose of my property as follows.

I give, devise and bequeath to my daughter Ruby Harbison all my property whatsoever, to have and to hold the same as her own absolutely.

In so doing I am mindful of the fact that I have heretofore made suitable provisions and advancements to my two sons and that my daughter Addie will receive such care from her brothers and sister as the occasion and her necessity shall require.

I hereby appoint and constitute said Ruby Harbison sole Executrix of this my last will and testament.

In witness whereof I have affixed my hand to this my last will and testament in the presence of J.D. Worsham and T.B. Cunningham as witnesses who in my presence and at my request do sign this instrument as such.

Witnesses this the 19th day of May 1909 at Kentland, Indiana.

BE IT REMEMBERED, that on the 2nd day of June 1910 T.B. Cunningham one of the subscribing witnesses to the within and foregoing last will and testament of Abigail Jordan, late of said County, deceased, personally appeared before Reuben Hess, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Newton County, in the State of Indiana, and being duly sworn by the Clerk of said Court, upon his oath declared and testified as follows, that is to say: that on the 19th day of May, 1909 he saw the said Abigail Jordan sign her name to said instrument in writing as and for her last will and testament; and that this deponent at the same time heard the said Abigail Jordan declare the said instrument in writing to be her last will and testament, and that the said instrument in writing was at the same time at the request of the said Abigail Jordan, and with her consent attested and subscribed by the said T.B. Cunningham and J.D. Worsham in the presence of said testator and in the presence of each other as subscribing witnesses thereto, and the said Abigail Jordan was at the time of the signing and subscribing of said instrument in writing as aforesaid, of full age, (that is more than twenty one years of age) and of sound and disposing mind and memory, and not under any coercion or restraint, as the said deponent verily believes and further deponent says not. Said Abigail Jordan died May 22nd, 1910.
